SCOPE OF PROJECT

The project consists of renovating 442 windows and 11 doors on 4 elevations of the original North (1899) Building of the Milwaukee Federal Building - U.S. Courthouse. The project is being completed in two phases to allow for seasonal work. Windows and doors were stripped to bare wood and refinished; or replaced if damage is beyond repair. Windows were reglazed with insulated glass, sashings and frames repaired and new weather stripping installed. Project included lead and asbestos abatement.
